ANNUAL MEETING/NATIONAL NIGHT OUT
2 October 2012

The University Estates North Annual Homeowners Meeting was held on 2 October 2012 in conjunction with the National Night Out. The meeting was held at Richardson East Church of Christ, 1504 E. Campbell Rd., Richardson, Texas. A time of visiting and eating began at 5:30PM. Nina Lassiter welcomed everyone.

Nina called the meeting to order at 6:10pm and thanked all those who had helped set up the meeting. She also noted that David Roffino, vice-president, was absent due to illness. She then introduced Detective Rasco, an 18 year veteran of the Richardson Police Department as our representative from the RPD.

Jim Arnett coordinated a skit utilizing some of our neighborhood school age residents to promote the city's recycling program. Richardson encourages all residents to participate in recycling and provides blue bags for each address. Additional bags were made available to attendees along with a copy of the Public Works Services Handbook for Richardson Residents.

Minutes of the 2011 meeting were read and approved. The treasurers' report was orally presented with the end of August balance of \$7535.11. Approximately 75 people were in attendance.

Old Business:

SIGN TOPPERS: On display was a drawing of the final signage submitted to the City of Richardson for approval. This signage has been approved and ordered. It should arrive within the next few weeks and will be installed by the City.

DUES: All dues paid as of 1 October 2012 will be for 2013.

FLAG PROGRAM: Stella Daniels gave a brief overview of the flag program and how to participate.

New Business:

NEXTDOOR PROGRAM: Jim Arnett gave a brief description of this on-line communication program that is available to our neighborhood. It provides a quick way to relay information to all residents who join.

CRIME WATCH: Our Crime Watch Patrol continues to patrol on a regular basis and our overall neighborhood crime is very low. There are a few foreclosed and/or abandoned homes in the neighborhood and we all need to be watchful of any activity at these.

MEETINGS: There will be a public meeting concerning the Lookout Transfer Station on October 9 and all are encouraged to attend. Information about the location and time was provided in a handout. Neighborhood Leadership workshops are held by the City and information is available on their website.
