## **NEIGHBORHOOD CRIMEWATCH** by Jim Arnett

Hello everyone,

Our long run of being crime-free came to an end recently with the theft of an automobile from one of our residents. The vehicle was stolen from inside a garage. While the method of entry to the garage is unclear, it is important to note the keys were left in the car. Fortunately, the car was equipped with a LoJack system and Richardson Police quickly located and recovered it while it was still in Richardson. Arrests have been made in this incident.

Our Crime Watch Patrol recorded only one instance of an open garage door during the month of October. This is really great news and it reinforces why we have so little theft and burglary in UEN. Criminal activity is generally down in the surrounding neighborhoods, but that is likely to change as Christmas approaches. Burglars understand that gifts will be in plain sight under the tree. Keep your draperies or blinds closed at night and when you are away from the home, and make sure all your windows and doors are securely locked – even when you are at home!

Attached to this newsletter is a flyer inviting you to join our new neighborhood social website called **Nextdoor**. We now have 77 homes active on this site and neighbors are beginning to share various recommendations and tips. New since our last newsletter, the Richardson Police Department is now using **Nextdoor** to post important crime prevention warnings and related information to area residents. This is a non-commercial site that will not share your contact information; membership is limited to the verified residents of our area. Similar to a community bulletin board, this site will allow all of us to share items of interest, coordinate neighborhood events, and so much more.
